Dr. Lu-Hung Chen is currently the President of International Life Sciences Institute (ILSI) Taiwan. Dr. Chen was the first person in Taiwan who had actively participated in ILSI Focal Point in China's activity, to harmonize the food safety standards among China, Taiwan, Hong Kong and Macau.

Dr. Chen has just retired from the Deputy Director-General position in the most important food research center in Taiwan, Food Industry Research and Development Institute (FIRDI). He was the Director of the Food Sanitation Department (now the Taiwan FDA) of Taiwan Department of Health (now the Ministry of Health and Welfare) before joining FIRDI. He has vast experience in research, government administration and industry R&D.
